Famous Sports in England

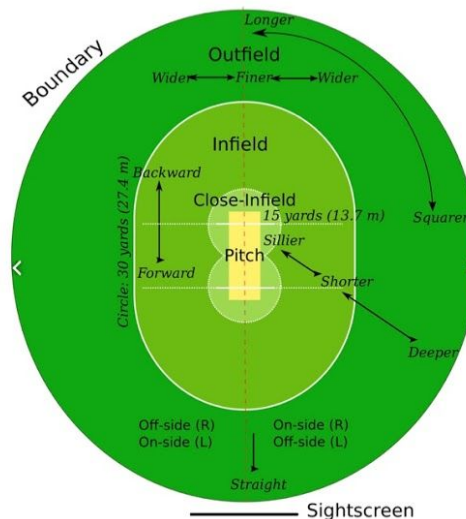
Cricket

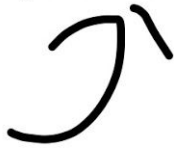
Famous Faces in Sports

Mariano Aguerre, he was born in Buenos Aires on 25 May 1968. He played polo.

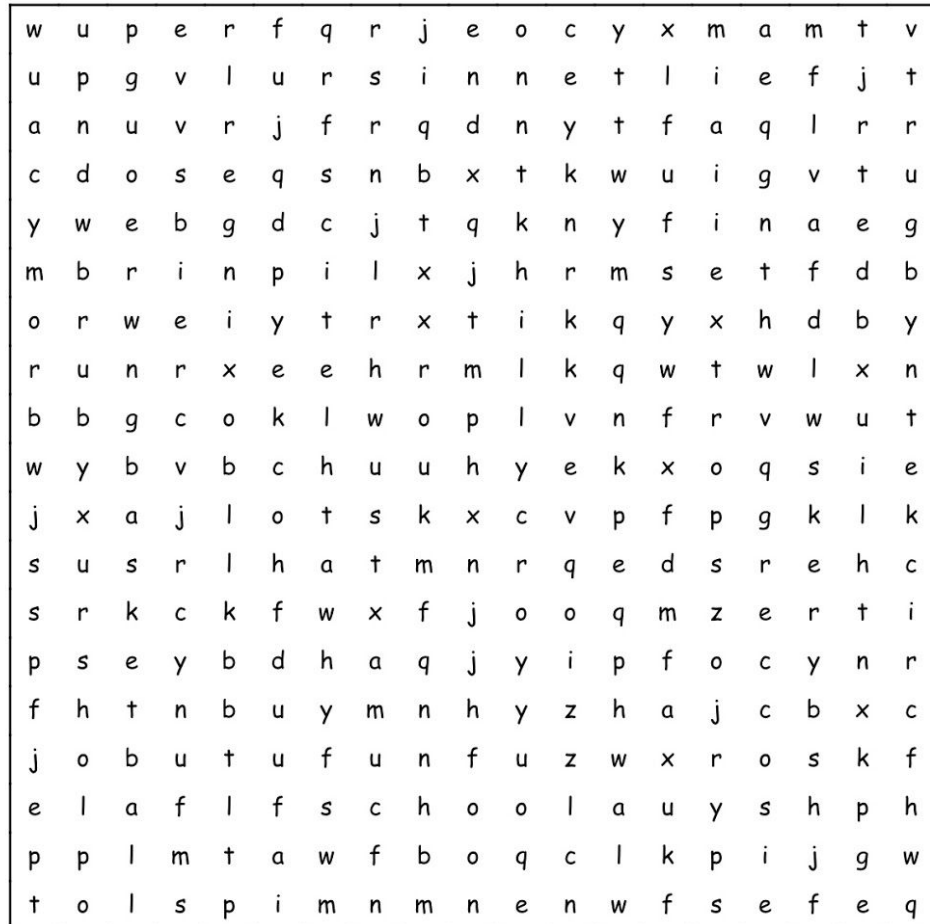


Joe Simpson is still a rugby player who started his career in 2011.

Wembley Stadium

- The Wembley Stadium is in Wembley which opened in 2007.
- The Stadium is the temporary home of the Premier League football club.
- It has 90,000 seats and is the largest stadium in the UK and the second largest stadium in Europe.
- It is 134-meter-high.
- The Stadium was built by Australian firm Multiplex at a cost of £798 million and £1.09 billion today.
- In addition to England home games and the FA cup final, the stadium also hosts other major games in English football.
- Opened 9 March 2007
- Wembley was designed by architects Foster+Partners and Populous and with engineers Mott Stadium consortium.
- It is one of the most expensive stadia ever built
- Wembley Stadium has the largest roof-covered seating capacity in the world.
